

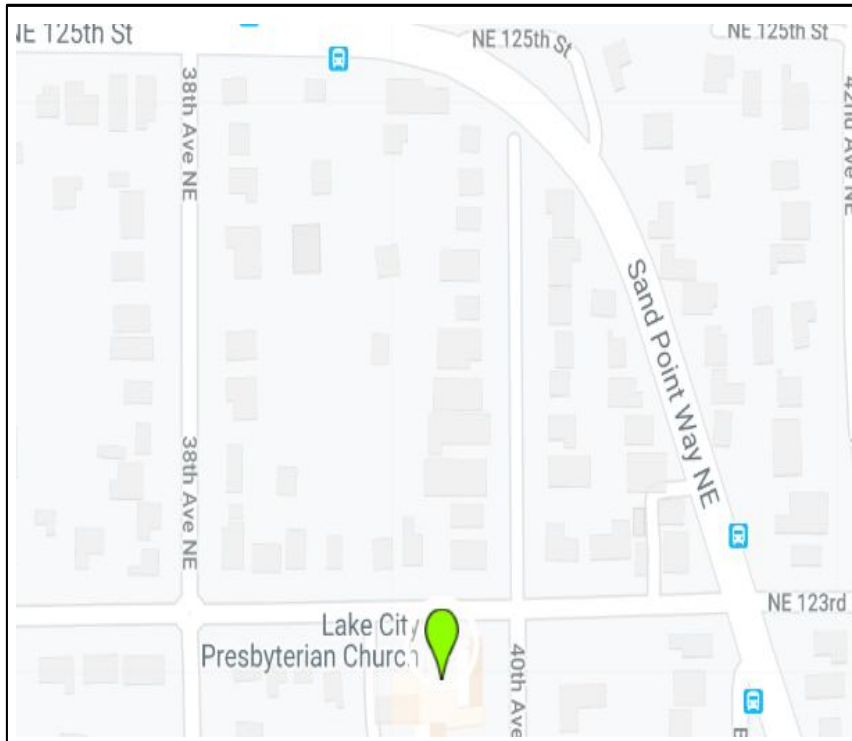

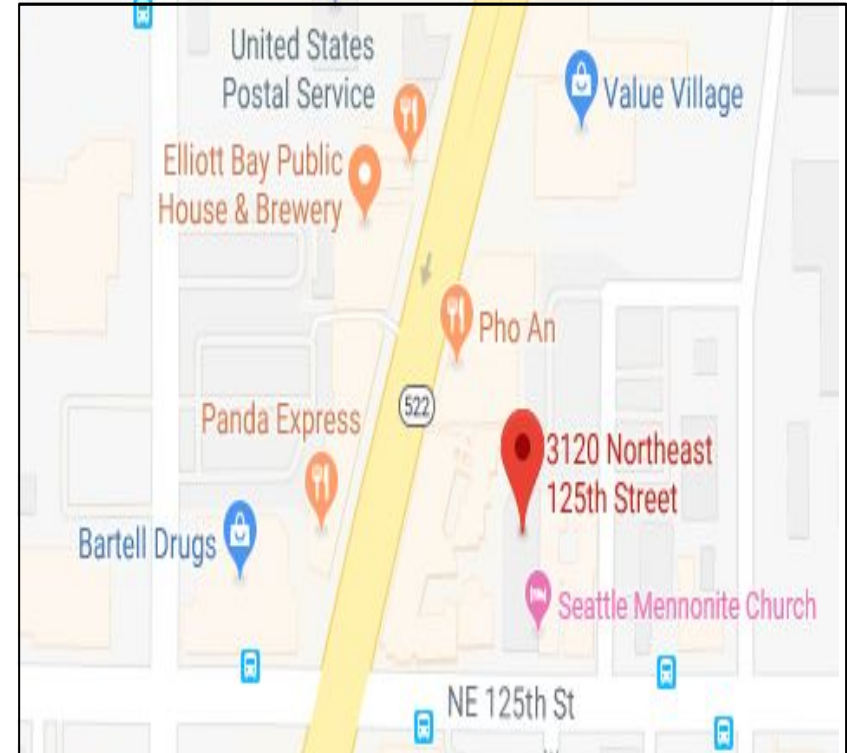

## North King County Winter Shelter Bus Routes

**1 Lake City Presbyterian Oct. 13 - Nov 29;** 3841 NE 123rd St, Seattle:

Take bus #75 (University District). Arrive at Sand Point Way NE & Bartlett. Walk approx 2 min (0.2 mi). Head north on Sand Point Way. Turn left onto NE 123rd St. Walk 1 block, destination on your left. Entrance on ground level ramp on NE 123rd St. Next to sanctuary entrance.

**2 Seattle Mennonite Church, Nov. 30 - TBD;** 3120 NE 125th St, Seattle:

Walk east on NE 125<sup>th</sup> to 3120 NE 125th St. (north side of 125<sup>th</sup>).

**Shelter will be accessed through front doors of SMC located on 125th; No entry through courtyard.**
